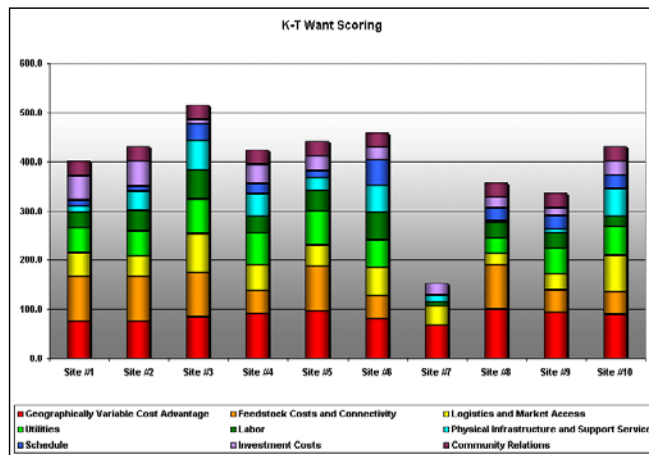


The Kepner-Tregoe Decision Process

The Kepner-Tregoe (KT) decision-making process provides a systematic evaluation structure that guarantees an orderly sequence of comparative evaluations in a measurable format.

The K-T decision analysis process begins in the alignment phase and continues throughout the project. K-T is a rational decision-making tool that is structured to alleviate bias and provide a framework from which decisions can be made and defended.

Site and building alternatives are first evaluated on factors that are "musts" that are essential characteristics that must be present in order for the alternative to be considered for further evaluation. After this screen, the alternatives are then evaluated on various factors using a scoring and ranking methodology to determine the relative desirability of a particular alternative
